### Dear Sponsor:

In the 19<sup>th</sup> century, St. Patrick's parades were a big thing in Detroit, but by the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, the custom had died out. From the 1920's to the 1950's, parades were occasionally put on by a single Irish Club acting on its own or by a particular Parish parading for a few blocks or even a single Irish family on it's own block. By the Late 1950's, the Irish in Detroit were ready for a major parade so the United Irish Societies (UIS) held the first parade in Dearborn in 1959. It was an instant success and there has been a UIS parade every year since. On Sunday, March 12, 2017, we will celebrate *the 59<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Patrick's Parade*.

For 25 years, the parade marched on Woodward Avenue in Downtown Detroit. It originally ended at the foot of the City-County Building. It moved to Kennedy Square after that area was renamed for President Kennedy. Starting in 1985, the UIS moved the Parade to Michigan Avenue through Corktown – Detroit's historic Irish neighborhood. The parade staging area was located at Michigan and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. The march went west along Michigan Avenue, passed the old Tiger Stadium and ended at the reviewing stand just past the Gaelic League at Wabash Street. In 2004, the staging area moved a few blocks west to Sixth Street where the new Irish Plaza had been dedicated.

The UIS runs the St. Patrick's Parade and is made up of delegates from the 35 Irish Organizations in the Detroit Metropolitan area. Every year the UIS selects a Grand Marshal as a reward for their lifelong contributions to the Irish Community. These Grand Marshals donate their time, business resources, financial resources and their personalities to the Irish Community promoting our Irish heritage, Culture and philanthropy. This year's Grand Marshal is Brian Dunleavy.

The Detroit St. Patrick's Parade is Detroit's oldest continuous ethnic parade. It is a traditional family day that has had great appeal based on the Irish Community in Detroit and raising more awareness for the Irish Culture and Heritage through Irish Dancing, Irish restaurants and events that support great charities.

With the support of the Detroit community, the Parade averages between 40,000 to 100,000 people lining the streets of Michigan Avenue celebrating their Irish Heritage while watching over 3,500 participants including Detroit High School bands, Family Clans, UIS Member groups, Pipe & Drum Bands, Detroit Fireman Clown Team, floats and dignitaries marching down Michigan Avenue through Historic Corktown.
